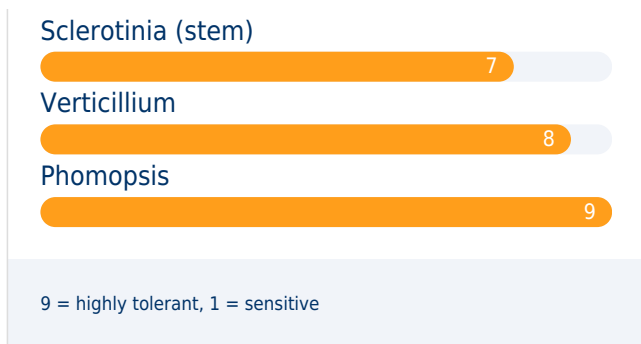

## Growing recommendations

Mas 81.K is able to value a really large range of cultivation conditions thanks to its earliness and a quick filling. Ideal hybrid for farmers who are starting sunflower crop and who would like to limit production risks. Moreover it is particularly interesting in case of late sowings, minimum tillage (need to wait more time for soil heating). Do not hesitate to increase plant density in high potential fields. Be careful to check the optimal harvest stage: natural shelling arrive more quickly
